The 2018 Chardonnay, sourced from the Carmel Mountain Range, was aged for eight months in French oak (87% used). It comes in at 13.2% alcohol. This is a terrific Chardonnay. The oak is beautifully handled and not intrusive even in this wine's youth. It shows good concentration and a better finish with some grip and lingering fruit. This is arguably the best Chardonnay I've seen from Bat Shlomo, granting that they are not all here together. It will be interesting to see if this can develop and improve over several years. It should hold well, but we'll see and take that in stages. This is not imported, but the winery does ship directly from Israel. There were 516 cases produced.
